Morris dancing is a great way to keep fit, meet new friends and you'll be keeping a tradition alive!

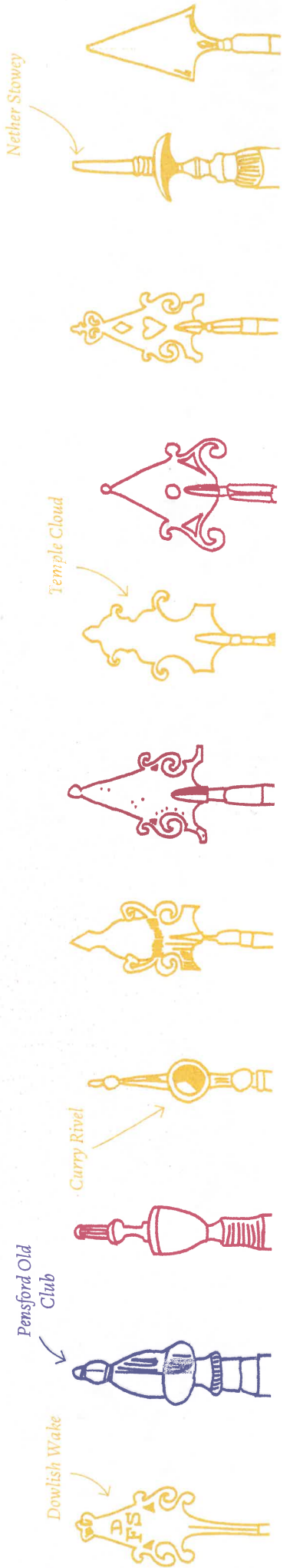


Dancing Cotswold Morris

Stave Dances

From village Friendly Societies in Somerset & Dorset, these dances are based on those described in Friendly Society minute books from approx. 200 years ago. Each dancer carries a 2m stave, bearing a distinctive brass emblem decorated with ribbons, Village Friendly Societies, forerunners of today's insurance companies, were mutual self-help groups for the working people which flourished in the early and mid 1800s.
